Information to candidates whose PH status has been changed after start of online registration for All India Quota PG Counseling

The National Board of Examinations (NBE) has informed that PH status of 34 candidates has been changed from 'Yes' to 'No' on the candidates' request due to non-availability of PH certificate with them.

The online counseling for PG has been started on 04.06.2013 on the basis of data provided by the NBE and more than 16,000 candidates have already registered using the database provided by the AIIMS/NBE, therefore the changed status of the PH at this stage is not acceptable. All such candidates are advised to fill in their details as per the rank letter issued before change of PH status/ MCC database. These candidates are advised to select non-PH PG seats in choice submission form, if eligible for non-PH seat of respective category. At the time of reporting in the allotted college/institute, candidates may ask college authorities to change the category from PH-'Yes' to PH-'No' as per existing procedure subject to fulfillment of score/ percentile requirement of non-PH category.
