**Sub: Counseling by DGHS, MOHFW for MBBS/BDS seats in ESIC Medical/Dental Colleges - reg.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the deliberations in the meeting held in your office on 30/06/2017 on the captioned subject; and to convey as under:

1. In line with the Admission policy & procedure for admission to ESIC UG (MBBS/BDS) courses in ESIC Medical/Dental colleges;
  - 1.1 The order of allotment of seats would be to Group-I; Group-II; and Group-III candidates, in that order, i.e. Candidates belonging to Group-I would be considered for allotment of available seats first, candidates of Group-II would be considered for unfilled/leftover seats after allotment to Group-I candidates and so forth.
  - 1.2 The merit list for each Group, i.e. Group-I; Group-II; and Group-III would be prepared, based on the rank /marks of eligible applicants in NEET(UG)-2017, consistent with the reservation policy of the Central Government, for preparation of category-wise inter-se merit.
2. The Group-I; Group-II; and Group-III above referred to are the 'Groups' under which the candidates would be issued 'Ward of IP' certificates.
3. As informed earlier, 'Ward of IP' certificate is an essential eligibility criteria for allotment of seats under 'Insured persons Quota'
4. May please be guided accordingly.
