Kind Attention:

It is for the information to all the candidates that as per the directions received from BOG, MCI vide letter no. MCI-7(9)/2019-Med./145069-71 dated 6th Sept.2019 the cut-off percentile for admission to NEET (SS) courses for the academic year 2019-20 has been lowered as under:

1. In the Super Speciality Course of CTVS, Cardiology and Paediatric Surgery, the percentile for eligibility has been brought down to 20th percentile.
2. For the remaining Super –Speciality courses, the percentile for eligibility has been reduced to 40th percentile.

Candidates who have become eligible after lowered percentile can register online as per schedule uploaded on MCC website.

The Eligibility for participation in Stray Vacancy Round is as under:

1. Registered Candidates Not Allotted any seat during Round-1 or Round-2 of the counselling. Such candidates can directly log in and do Choice Filling.
2. Candidates who have become eligible after Reduced Cut- off percentile can do Fresh Registration after payment of fees.

Attention:- Candidates who are allotted a seat in Stray Vacancy Round and do not join the allotted college will get their Security deposit forfeited.

Madam,

Please refer to subject captioned. The Board of Governors reviewed the proposal in terms of vacant seats and the number of additional eligible candidates to be provided for filling the vacancies in Super-Speciality Courses. In principle it was decided that the reduction in percentile should provide atleast double the number of vacant seats. Based on the above, the following decisions were taken:-

- (i) In the Super-speciality of CTVS, Cardiology and Paediatric Surgery, the percentile for eligibility may be brought down to 20th percentile.
- (ii) For the remaining Super-speciality courses, the percentile for eligibility may be reduced to 40th percentile.
