SURRENDER OF VACANT ALL INDIA QUOTA UG SEATS TO RESPECTIVE STATES/ UNIVERSITIES

As per scheme of All India Quota UG Online Counseling for 15% MBBS/BDS seats, approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in I.A. No. 32/2012 in Civil Appeal no. 443 of 1992 filed by Sharwan Kumar vs Dte. GHS, order dated 07.06.2012, the All India Quota UG seats (MBBS/BDS) of 2015, remaining vacant due to non-joining and resignation by allotted candidates after the conclusion of 3rd round of All India counseling stand surrendered (reverted) to the respective States/Universities with immediate effect (on 17.09.2015).

It may please be noted that all available seats were allotted in Round-3 of the All India Quota Counseling.

The surrender (reversion) of vacant seats was deferred till 16.09.2015 in compliance of the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala dated 11/09/2015 passed in Writ Petition no. 27518/2015 filed by Rohan Nebu Vs Union of India and Others.

In compliance of the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala, at Ernakulum, order dated 11.09.2015, in Writ Petition (C) Number 26256 / 2015, filed by Ms Ananya Manish, the Director Medical Education, Secretary – Medical Education, Government of Kerala, and Commissioner of Entrance Examination, Thiruvananthapuram are requested to keep one seat of Medical

College in Kerala vacant for 10 days (as per order dated 11.09.2015).
