**3<sup>RD</sup> (MOP-UP) COUNSELING NOTICE**

**ADMISSION OF 'WARDS OF INSURED PERSONS' (IPs) IN UG COURSE  
(MBBS/BDS) IN ESIC MEDICAL/DENTAL COLLEGES under 'INSURED  
PERSONS (IPs) QUOTA' FOR ACADEMIC SESSION 2017-18.**

1. In continuation of two round of counseling conducted by Directorate General Health Services, GoI, ESIC has been permitted to conduct mop-up counseling (3<sup>rd</sup> counseling), including for balance seats conveyed by the DGHS at the end admissions after Round-2 of Allotment.
2. **Only 'Wards of Insured persons' who had registered for 1<sup>st</sup> / 2<sup>nd</sup> counseling on the MCC website for admission to UG course (MBBS/BDS) in ESIC Medical/Dental and other Medical Colleges under 'Insured Persons Quota' for academic session 2017-18, are eligible to participate in the said counseling process.**
3. The counseling would be done as from amongst, (i) candidates allotted BDS seat for the first time in second round of counseling and had reported and completed the admission process; (ii) balance left over candidates already registered on the MCC web site up to 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2017, i.e. who were never allotted any college in the ratio of 1:6 category wise.
4. Option for change of college/course is **not available** to candidates (i) who have already been given a chance to do so earlier; and (ii) who have already been allotted MBBS seats in 1<sup>st</sup> / 2<sup>nd</sup> round of counseling.

\*Erstwhile proposed ESIC Colleges at serial No.(8) to (10) have been transferred to respective State Governments to run these colleges. These colleges have to contribute seats to the 'pool' of seats for 'Insured Persons (IPs) Quota' as per terms of MoU for transfer of these colleges.

**Note:** The reservation in r/o of the above balance seats is as conveyed by DGHS in line with extant rules.

## **7. Mechanism for filling up of 'Insured Persons Quota' seats as above**

**7.1** The '**guiding principles**' for filling up of '**Insured Persons Quota**' will be as under:-

**7.1.1** The 'Insured Persons Quota' seats will be filled on merit cum preference basis.

**7.1.2** The counseling would be done as from amongst, (i) candidates allotted BDS seat for the first time in second round of counseling and had reported and completed the admission process; (ii) balance left over candidates already registered on the MCC web site up to 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2017, i.e. who were never allotted any college in the ratio of 1:6 category wise or all candidates, whichever is higher.

**7.1.3** The order of allotment of seats would be to Group-I; Group-II; and Group-III candidates, in that order, i.e. Candidates belonging to Group-I would be considered for allotment of available seats first, candidates of Group-II would be considered for unfilled/leftover seats after allotment to Group-I candidates and so forth.

**7.1.4** The merit list for each Group, i.e. Group-I; Group-II; and Group-III would be prepared, based on the rank /marks of eligible applicants in NEET(UG)-2017, for preparation of category-wise inter-se merit.

**7.1.5** Candidates seeking admission under 'Insured Persons Quota' **during he mop-up (3<sup>rd</sup>) counseling** will have to *fulfill the following eligibility criteria:*

- a) Minimum eligibility criteria for admission will be as per MCI regulations.
- b) Candidate must possess proof of valid registration on the MCC website.**
- c) No change is permitted in details submitted to the MCC during Registration**
- d) Applicant must have a valid "Ward of Insured Person" Certificate, issued by the designated Authority, i.e. concerned Regional Director/SRO I/C, under Gr. I/II/III.**
- e) The selection and admission to MBBS seats in any Medical Institution recognized for running MBBS Courses as per Indian Medical Council Act 1956 is subject to fulfilling the admission criteria, eligibility, medical fitness and such other criteria as may be prescribed by the Universities etc. In event of any difference in criteria of MCI and Affiliating University etc., the higher criteria will prevail.

- f) Applicants are advised to refer to the websites of the Affiliating Universities, i.e. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences (RGUHS) for ESIC colleges in Karnataka; West Bengal University of Health Sciences (WBUHS) for ESIC college in West Bengal; The Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University (TNMGRMU) for ESIC colleges (including erstwhile proposed medical colleges) in Tamil Nadu; and Pt. BD Sharma University of Health Sciences for ESIC college in Haryana, Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences (KNRUHS), for ESIC college in Telangana; **and** Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla; Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS) for erstwhile proposed medical college in Mandi, Himachal Pradesh and Paripally, Kollam, Kerala respectively, for further information.

#### **7.1.6 Methodology for filling up of Insured Persons (IPs) Quota for 2017-18**

- a) Candidates will have to pre-register and get their original documents verified at any one of the six designated Centers, as per convenience, **on 25<sup>th</sup> August (Friday), 2017 between 9.30 am to 1 pm (Thursday)**. The designated centers are as under:
- ◆ ESIC Medical College, Faridabad (Haryana)
  - ◆ ESIC Medical College, Joka, Kolkata (WB)
  - ◆ ESIC Medical College, KK Nagar, Chennai (TN)
  - ◆ ESIC Medical College, Sanathnagar, Hyderabad (Telangana)
  - ◆ ESIC Medical College, Rajajinagar, Bengaluru (Karnataka)
  - ◆ ESIC Medical College, Gulbarga (Karnataka)
- b) Candidates **must carry listed documents in original** along with self-attested copies for verification, failing which they will not be allowed to complete the pre-counseling and document registration process
- (i) Proof of registration on the MCCC website;
  - (ii) Valid "Ward of Insured Person" Certificate, issued by the designated Authority, i.e. concerned Regional Director/SRO I/C under Gr. I/II/III.
  - (iii) Secondary School Certificate which must bear Date of Birth or Birth Certificate.
  - (iv) Senior Secondary School certificate (+2). Provisional if final has not been issued.
  - (v) Admit card for in National Eligibility cum Entrance Test-2016 [NEET (UG) - 2017]
  - (vi) Score card [NEET - 2017]\_with Rank Position i.e. All India Rank

- (vii) 'Ward of Insured Person' Certificate from Competent Authority
- (viii) SC/ST Certificate in prescribed format
- (ix) OBC Certificate in prescribed format
- (x) Physically Handicapped Certificate from 'Appropriate Authority' as specified by the concerned State/UT Government subject to verification by Competent ESIC Board, if required.
- (xi) **For FEMALE CANDIDATES ONLY**
