


BOND CONDITIONS AND SECURITY DEPOSITS

- 1) As per Maharashtra Government Resolution (G.R.No.MED 1007/CR-490/07/Ed-2 dated 8th Feb 2008 and any G.R. issued in this regard from time to time), candidates joining against the seats of Government / Municipal Corporation colleges for admission to MBBS/BDS courses either through GOI nominee, All India Quota or through NEET UG 2019 will be required to sign a bond to serve the Government of Maharashtra or local self government or Defense services/Kasturba Health Society for a period of one year, after the completion of internship, failing which he/she will be required to pay Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees ten lacs only) for the default as penalty.

Additionally, he/she will be required to sign an undertaking to the effect that he / she will not leave India within a period of five years from the date of obtaining the degree, otherwise he/she will have to pay Rs.10,00,000/- (Rs. Ten lacs only) as penalty.

- 2) **FOR LAPSE OF SEAT-** As per Maharashtra Government Resolution No.CET 3516/CR 169/Edu-2 dated 13/04/2017 any candidate responsible for lapse of seat will have to pay a penalty of **Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lacs Only)**. This penalty is applicable to all those candidates who do not join during last round or cancel a seat after last round of admission. This penalty is also applicable to any candidate resigning a seat after cutoff date for MBBS/BDS course or also fails to complete the course, irrespective of admission quota of the candidate.
- 3) The candidate selected for admission to MBBS course will deposit Security Deposit (which are included in consolidated amount to be paid at the time of admission) as under:-
- An amount of **Rs.30,000/- [Rs. Thirty Thousand]** which shall continue to be retained as Security Deposit till the time of successful completion of the prescribed Internship Training by the concerned candidate. Such deposit, subject to recovery, if any, may bear the simple interest at the rate applicable to Saving Bank Account as per RBI Norms and as shall be decided by the Society from time to time.
 - An amount of **Rs.70,000/- [Rs. Seventy Thousand]** – while in case of S.C./S.T./V.J./N.T candidate at Rs.50,000/- [Rs. Fifty Thousand] which shall continue to be retained as Security Deposit till the induction of an authenticated evidence in the Office of Dean, MGIMS in support of successful completion by the concerned students of a service in Area of need for such period as prescribed by Kasturba Health Society, Sevagram, after completing the term of his / her internship training. Such deposit, subject to recovery, if any, may bear the simple interest at the rate applicable to Saving Bank Account as per RBI Norms and as shall be decided by the Society from time to time.
 - The amounts of Security deposit so retained shall be refunded only on production of Original Receipt, issued at the time of respective deposits appended to the claim for refund, if any.



CODE OF CONDUCTS, RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Students admitted to Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Sevagram are expected to follow the code of conduct as follows :
 - a. Wearing khadi clothes
 - b. Consume vegetarian meals
 - c. Eschew smoking, drinking and other intoxicants
 - d. Participate in community prayer, shramdan and such other activities as may be prescribed from time to time
 - e. Must be free from any prejudice regarding caste, creed or untouchability.
2. Residing in the hostels of the Institute is compulsory for all students
3. Students after admission to the Institute are given an Orientation Training Course for a fortnight in Sevagram Ashram for getting sensitized to Gandhian ideology
4. Attendance in the Social Service camp for 15 days in an adopted village in Wardha District. The participation in Social Service Camp is essential.
5. We shall also follow other conditions as prescribed by Government of Maharashtra, Govt. of India and by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.
